Fast Starts: September 17, 2018 @ 12:01 am

Fast Ends: October 7, 2018 @ 12:00 pm

Week 1: September 17-September 23:

12:01am-3:00pm: water, juice, green tea, and protein shakes

Week 2: September 24-September 30:

No bread, no pork, no beef, no fried foods, no soda, no sweets

Week 3: October 1– October 7:

Something of your choice

Word on Wednesday Bible Study: 12 noon and 7pm in the Chapel

Week 1: Scriptures, Prayer and Declarations

John 4:34-38 (NLT)

Galatians 6:7-9 (KJV)

Joel 2:23-24 (NLT)

Dear Heavenly Father,

You are the only true and living God, and I adore Your presence. Your faithfulness and loving kindness are better than life. Awesome are the works of Your hand, and I submit to Your glory and power. You are the Lord of the Harvest, and I declare You are the Lord of my life. I DECREE and DECLARE that I am walking into a new season. In this season, I will see the Harvest of the Lord upon my life. The blessing of God is on my life, and the Blood of Jesus covers my soul. Guide my footsteps, oh God, and lead me to the place You have already predestined. Thank You for Your love. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Declarations

- I DECREE and DECLARE that the seed of the Word of God is within me. My body will bring Glory to the name of Jesus. My mind will remain steadfast on the Kingdom, and my spirit is in total alignment with my Heavenly Father. Nothing shall be impossible for me.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that the Lord of the Harvest is watching carefully over me. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil. God is doing a great work in me and I will see my Harvest in my lifetime.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that my name is on multiple streams of income that are flowing into my house. The spirit of poverty, lack, and laziness have no place in my Harvest season. I will be a life giving resource to the nations of the world, and show forth the power and love of Jesus Christ.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that I will not lose heart in doing good, for in due time I will reap if I do not grow weary. Just like a good farmer, I will remain diligent in my seeking and I will not let go of God's hand. My praise is my weapon, and I will win.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that I will give and receive. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will it be put into my lap. This season of Harvest will change my life. I will no longer be the same.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that a supernatural release of hungry souls are coming from the north, south, east, and west. I arrest and speak boldly to every spirit that seeks to exalt itself against the knowledge of God. For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Devil, release your hold, and let God's people go.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that I will accomplish everything God has placed in my heart. I have not missed my window of opportunity. The Lord of the Harvest has been preparing me for this season. This is my time. This is my moment. I will receive it today.

Declarations

- I DECREE and DECLARE that my Harvest will prove that God's principles are eternally at work. I will reap what I have sown. God is accelerating the process, and He will make good on every promise He has made.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that a supernatural healing anointing will rest upon my family. The oil of the Holy Spirit shall change every negative report and crush every sickness and disease. Our bodies are whole because of the finished work of Calvary.
- I DECREE and DECLARE my Harvest is healthy and full of life. Each vine is strong because I am eternally planted in Jesus Christ. He has taught me to prune carefully, water generously, and to remain in the light of His glory. I know my time for great Harvest is now.

- I DECREE and DECLARE that this season of Harvest will cause men and women to hear the heart of God and experience the fullness of His Love. They shall be totally delivered and totally set free. This is their coming out season, because whom the Son has set free; is free indeed.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that the power of God is upon this new season of Harvest. Supernatural healing, abundant blessings, and over bounding favor shall be my daily experience. My body is healed and full of God's mercy and strength.
- I DECREE and DECLARE that I am reaping peace and joy in this Harvest. I will not dread disease, linger in worry, or suppress what God has done for me. God's presence is with me, therefore; I will rejoice and be glad.
- I DECREE and DECLARE the abundant rain of God is bringing life to every dry place. The ground of my heart is producing a Harvest that will eternally redirect my family and this generation. New branches full of life are springing forth, and the Joy of the Lord is my strength.

- No Sweets

- Minimum of 15 mins uninterrupted conversation with parents/guardian
- 5 mins of prayer time in your "Prayer Closet"
- Create a prayer plan, listing areas that you would like to pray about (Family members by name, school, friends by name, negative habits, etc). Use this listing to guide your prayer during the fast.

Youth Week 2

All of the above plus

- No Instagram
- No Periscope
- No Twitter
- No Texting after 8pm
- No TV after 9pm
- 10 mins of Prayer Time (Use Prayer Plan)
- Minimum of 25 mins uninterrupted conversation with parents
- Sit down and write an action plan on how you hope to achieve your "Harvest" during this fast. What necessary steps will you take.

Youth Week 3

All of the above plus

- No Social Media
- No Internet unless for school
- Minimum of 30 mins uninterrupted conversation with parents daily
- 15 mins of prayer for teachers, friends, and family in your "Prayer Closet" (Use Prayer Plan)
- Write a letter to God on how you want to improve your relationship with Him. Share and review it with your parents, and keep it in a secure place to visit at a later time.
