

Six Styles of Evangelism

1. Direct Style - Peter (Acts 2:14 NIV)

2 Timothy 4:2 NIV

Caution: Be sure to use tact when confronting people with truth, Don't offend!

2. Intellectual Style - Paul (Acts 17:2 NIV)

1 Peter 3:15 NIV

Caution: Don't substitute giving answers for sharing the Gospel Message. Don't become argumentative, learn to be a good listener.

3. Testimonial Style - Blind man (John 9:25 NIV)

1 John 1:3 NIV

Caution: Talk about Jesus and what He's done, not simply about yourself. Bring glory to Him.

4. Interpersonal Style - Matthew (Luke 5:29 NIV)

1 Corinthians 9:22 NIV

Caution: Do not value friendship over truth telling.

5. Invitational Style - Woman at the Well (John 4 NIV)

Luke 14:23 NIV

Caution: Make sure the invitation is authentic.

6. Serving Style - Dorcas (Acts 9:36 NIV)

Matthew 5:16 NIV

Caution: Make sure your act of service makes room for sharing the Good News.
